The Draw Shot Challenge (DSC) is the average distance of all the individual Last Stone Draw stones, which were delivered by a team during the round robin. Where a total of 11 or fewer individual stones have been delivered, the single least favourable result is automatically eliminated before calculating the average distance. Where more than 11 individual stones have been delivered, the two least favourable results will be eliminated before calculating the average distance.

For teams with equal DSC, the team with the best non-equal counting LSD receives the higher ranking. In case all counting LSDs are equal, the team ranked higher in the WCF World Ranking is ranked higher.
